AN EARLY HISTORY OF CONCORD, CALIFORNIA

Once the Town of Todos Santos on the Land Grant of Monte Del Diablo

A small tribelet of Chupcan (Bay Miwok) Indians were the first inhabitants of our valley. Dominated by a great mountain to their south, the Chupcan lived along the valley's streams which flowed north to the wide tule marshes on the edge of the Bay. They shared the valley, and the oak-covered hills with tremendous herds of elk, deer and antelope. Salmon filled the streams; grizzly bears roamed foothills.

It wasn't until 1772 that Spanish explorer, led by Captain Pedro Fages and Father Juan Crespi, became the first outsiders to cross this area. In 1776, Lt. Colonel Juan Bautista de Anza, Lt. Jose Joaquin Moraga, and Father Pedro Font -- after leading the first colonists from Mexico to Monterey, California -- would be the next Europeans to visit the valley. For the next 50-60 years, the Spanish would explore, but not settle in our valley.

In 1828, Don Salvio Pacheco, whose ancestors were soldier-colonists with Anza, petitioned the Mexican government for lands in the valley. A native California and retired Spanish militiaman, Don Salvio was serving as a senior civil servant at the Pueblo of San Jose when he finally received the "Monte del Diablo" land grant in 1834. The 17,921 acre grant covered our valley from the Walnut Creek channel east to the hills, and generally from the Mt. Diablo foothills north to the BAY.

THE name "Monte del Diablo" which was assigned to Don Salvio's land grant, and ultimately to his Rancho, originally had been used by Spanish soldiers to describe a dense thicket (monte) of willows at the north end of our valley. The soldiers believed the thicket was possessed by evil, devilish Indian spirits, hence the name, "Monte del Diablo" - thicket of the devil.

Don Salvio's son, Fernando Pacheco, was sent immediately to occupy the grant and begin cattle operations on the Pacheco family's new Rancho. Don Salvio would not move his entire family to the Rancho until 1846, when a series of revolts by new American settlers swept the Mexican government from Alta California.

The Rancho Monte del Diablo prospered. Don Salvio's grand adobe, which is still located in downtown Concord, became the business, social and cultural center of the region. Don Fernando's adobe, now a nationally registered historical landmark, was built several miles north on low hills overlooking the Bay.

Don Salvio Pacheco, his son Fernando, and his son-in-law Francisco Galindo would provide the solution. In 1868, they arranged for a town plan to be surveyed for them on the bluffs near Don Salvio's adobe at the center of their Rancho. They called their new town TODOS SANTOS (All Saints), and in 1869, offered lots free to the merchants and residents of Pacheco.

The Todos Santos town plan was sited diagonally across the road which connected Clayton and its busy coal fields to the old docks at Pacheco. The new town would cover 20 acres and be divided into 19 blocks and a public plaza. Its perimeter was marked by Bonifacio Street on the northwest, East Street on the northeast, Contra Costa Street on the southeast, and Galindo Street on the southwest.



THE name Todos Santos would not identify the new town for long. Within months after Todos Santos has been recorded as the official name, **CONCORD** was heralded by the *Contra Costa Gazette* as the actual name. In an article dated April 17, 1869, the paper, published in Pacheco town, congratulated the residents of Concord for adopting such a meaningful name for their new village. They highlighted the harmonious spirit and euphony of this fine name. Despite later published reminders and protests by Fernando Pacheco, Concord became the name of our new town.

SAM Bacon was the first Pacheco town merchant to move to Todos Santos/Concord. In 1869, he reopened his general merchandise store on the north corner of Salvio and Galindo Streets. Other merchants would quickly follow; Concord would prosper as an agricultural support community for central contra Costa County. By 1879, a population of 300 was reported. It would double by February 1905, when incorporation of the "Town of Concord" was approved by a local two-vote margin.

IT would take 35 years for the population to double again. Small town Concord would begin World War II with an extraordinary high school, a modern hospital, five churches, two railroads, a fine library, a nationally-recognized central plaza, two cinemas, a full-service downtown commercial area, tree-lined streets, comfortable homes, and a population of only 1,400. The war years brought exposure; the post-war years began a population boom. Our growing bedroom community, then with a population of about 6,500, became the "City of Concord" in January 1948. Today, the farms, orchards and the old Rancho are neighborhoods; the classic old downtown has a multi-story skyline. Concord has a diverse population approaching 125,000, and prepares to welcome the year 2000 as the largest city in Contra Costa County. Confident of its future, Concord is especially proud of its rich history.

John F. Baldwin Park - 18 acres located north of Bonifacio Street and east of Port Chicago Highway with entrances at Beach Street and Parkside Drive. Concord Senior Citizens' Center, pre-school classrooms, childcare facility, dance studio, one reservable group picnic/ barbeque area, individual picnic tables with barbeques scattered throughout the park, basketball court, softball field, fitness/exercise course and unique children's play area.

BART Linear Park - Port Chicago Highway between Salvio Street and North Concord/Martinez BART Station (Panoramic Way).

BART Park - 5 acres under Bay Area Rapid Transit tracks between Mt. Diablo Street and Syston Drive. Meandering path, landscaped with trees, lawn and ground cover parallels Mesa Street and San Miguel Road.

Bayview Park - 3.4 acres on north side of Bayview Circle east of Port Chicago Highway. Landscaping and play equipment.

Boatwright Sports Complex - South of Ygnacio Valley Road, east of Alberta.

Brazil Quarry Park - 4 acres end of Kent Way off Sutherland. Open play space, natural creek, paved perimeter path and play equipment.

Cambridge Park - 10 acres on the east side of Victory Lane and west of Cambridge School. Informal ballfields, turf play areas, picnic tables, shade trees, and a children's play area.

Concord Boulevard Park - 8 acres on north side of Concord Boulevard between Mendocino Drive and Denkinger Road, next to Concord High School. Turfed mounded terrain with shade trees. Large open meadow, picnic facilities, children's play area and raised concrete stage. Children's playground will be renovated during Spring 2001.

Concord Community Park - 30 acres off north side of Cowell Road between Hale Drive and Sheridan Road next to El Monte School. Concord Community Pool is an Olympic size swimming pool, with diving facilities, wading pool, heated change rooms with showers and lockers. Park facilities include seven unlighted tennis courts, handball/tennis practice wall, ballfield and backstop, large open turf area, and a children's play area with a castle theme. There are two reservable group picnic/barbeque areas and many individual picnic tables with barbeques scattered throughout the park.

Ellis Lake Park - 10 acres south of Clayton Road and east of Ellis Street. Rolling turf and a paved path around the lake, which is home to many species of waterfowl and several turtles. A children's play area scheduled to be renovated during 2001-02. Historic Keller House serves as office for community service agencies.

Len Hester Park - 4 acres at corner of Hookston Road and Hampton Drive. Gently rolling terrain with lawn and trees suitable for children's play. A path winds through the park to several picnic areas.



Highlands Park - 9 acres next to Highlands School off north side of Pine Hollow Road between Pennsylvania Boulevard and Louisiana Drive. Rolling turfed terrain with variety of trees and meandering paths. Two creative play areas for children, ballfields and several picnic spots.

Hillcrest Community Park - 26 acres at Grant Street and Olivera Road. Athletic fields for softball, baseball and soccer, a model airplane flying area, and a children's play area with a train motif. There are several picnic areas with one reservable group site. A creek runs through the park. A Korean War Memorial is located in a quiet corner of the park near a pond and redwood grove. The historic Don Fernando Pacheco Adobe is next to the park.

Lime Ridge Open Space - 159 acres northwest of Treat Boulevard in area between San Miguel and Cowell Roads. Primary access from parking lot off Treat Boulevard. Improvements completed in 1993 include trails linked to regional network, benches, view areas and a community building. Extensive plantings of native oaks, grasses and wildflowers will restore the natural oak/savanna grassland, increasing the diversity and abundance of wildlife.

Markham Nature Area - 16 acres off northeast side of Cowell Road near Babel Lane and at south end of LaVista Avenue. Galindo Creek meanders through the park. Buildings in the park include a Nature Study Center used by Mt. Diablo School District, the Garden Center headquarters of the Markham Arboretum Society (<http://www.markhamarboretum.org>).

Meadow Homes Park - 12 acres at northwest corner of Sunshine and Detroit Avenue, next to Meadow Homes School. The park features a swimming pool, ballfields, basketball courts, and climbing bars for active play. There is one reservable group picnic/barbeque area that is scheduled for renovation during Summer 2001. The new facility will be the first group picnic site to be covered with a shade shelter.

Newhall Community Park - 122 acres along Galindo Creek east of Treat Boulevard. Access is via Newhall Parkway south of Clayton Road or from Turtle Creek Road. Galindo Creek meanders through the park. Approximately 30 acres of park is improved with ponds along creek, picnic areas, bocce courts, and turfed athletic fields. There is one reservable group picnic area. Most of the park is undeveloped open space. Over two miles of multi-use trails, linked to the regional network, are available for walkers, hikers, joggers, bicyclists and horseback riders. From the top of the hill, one is rewarded with sweeping views from the Carquinez Straits to Mount Diablo. A Vietnam War Memorial graces the vista point.

Rick Seers Neighborhood Park - 3/4 acre, northeast side of Sierra Road between Fox Meadow and Fox Way. Neighborhood greenbelt with landscaped pathway. Amenities include a picnic area, play equipment and a half basketball court.



Sun Terrace Park - 2.6 acres at corner of Vancouver Way and Montreal Circle. Turfed area for free play and a sand lot children's play area with swings, slide and climbing apparatus.

Todos Santos Park - 2.5 downtown acres between Salvio Street, Willow Pass Road, Grant Street and Mt. Diablo Street. Dedicated to the people of Concord by town founder Don Salvio Pacheco more than 125 years ago. Recent renovations include a turfed area with large trees, colorful flowers, picnic tables, benches and a small children's play area. A granite stage and fountain enhance the many community events held in this historic "town square".

Willow Pass Community Park - 40 acres north of Willow Pass Road at Olivera Road and Salvio Street. A large community center is located near the center of the park. Nearby are four lighted and four unlighted tennis courts. Turfed areas in the park include six softball fields, three are lighted for evening play, and a batting cage concession. Pixieland, a children's amusement area at the north end of the park features a scale model train ride around the lake and through a tunnel.

Ygnacio Valley Park - 9.5 acres at northeast corner of Oak Grove and Minert Roads near the BART tracks. Informal ballfields, picnic and barbeque facilities (including one reservable group site), a children's play area and large expanse of turf for free play.

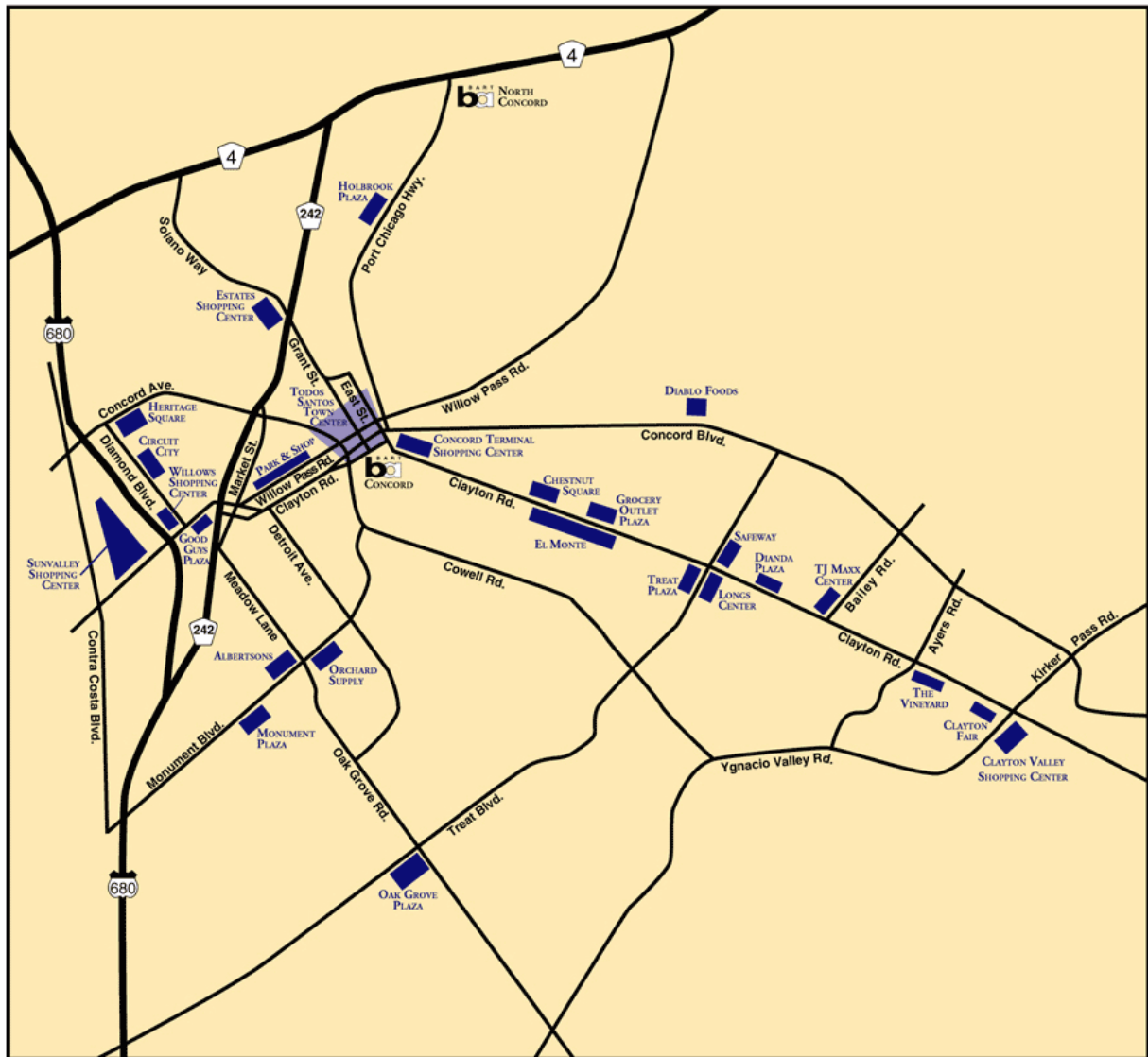
