Altamont Pass Windfarms, located along the old Altamont Pass Road and the 580 Freeway between Livermore and Tracy. This is the largest power plant fueled by wind in the world. Since 1981, over 7,300 wind turbines have been installed. By 1992, they produced over 6,000 million kilowatt-hours of electricity, enough energy to meet the needs of about 800,000 California homes for a full year.

Lawrence Livermore National Laboratory Visitor's Center, on Greenville Road, provides an overview of the Lab's current research programs and their applications. The Center's self-guided format encourages visitors to examine the displays and videos at their own pace. To confirm hours of operation call (925)422-6408. You can also tour the Laboratory and visit Nova, the world's largest, most powerful laser, and the National Energy Research Super Computer Center.

Historic Tours and Museums Historic sites and buildings abound. Visit the History Center and Art Gallery and pick up a walking tour map of the downtown area. You just might meet an old timer who knew world heavyweight boxer Max Baer or world champion all-around cowboy Johnnie Scheider.
