MONTCLAIR

The commercial district known as Montclair Village which is east of the Oakland hills residential district known as Montclair. This village is well established with locally owned shops, restaurants, and other vital businesses reside in a unique small-town atmosphere.

Montclair got its name in about 1920 when developers marketing it's first subdivision held a contest to name the area. Montclair was apparently selected because of its resemblance to Montclair New Jersey. By 1925 approximately 300 Real Estate Agents were extolling the virtues of living high in the Eastbay Hills.

In the 1920's, Montclair was touting its proximity to Oakland's City Hall (11 minutes) and San Francisco's Ferry Building (41 minutes). Back in 1911, Construction had begun on the Eastern Railroad that rolled into and out of Montclair until 1957. These factors influenced the development of the region perhaps more than any other during that era. Traces of these pioneering Rail lines are still evident in Montclair today.

The end of WWII brought another barrage of residential development that brought Montclair nearly to its present state.

Montclair Village is only minutes from three major freeways, Bart, and the AC Transit bus system. A walk through the Village you can find clothing stores, ice cream shops, gift stores, cleaners, and hair salons.

Montclair Village is surrounded by many homes which has a view of the San Francisco Bay. The local residents enjoy hiking in the 41,000 acres of surrounding East Bay Regional Parks. Many of the residents enjoy both small town living and proximity to downtown Oakland and San Francisco.
